- (make-ups will be scheduled within these 3 days)
- Students who are exempt from all tests do not have to attend these days
- Students may be checked out after their LAST semester test of each day with a note from their parents.
- Students may not leave and return to take another test the same day
- Students who are exempt from tests earlier in the day may arrive and check in at that test's scheduled time.

SEMESTER TESTS Semester tests shall be given in all academic classes in grades 7-12. Each nine-week average counts 40% of the semester average and the semester test counts 20% of the semester average for a total of 100 % of the semester average. Students in grade 12 will not take semester tests for the second semester of their 12th-grade year. Students in grades 7-12 may choose to be exempt from semester tests if they meet the following criteria:

1. The student's semester average is an "A" in the class and the student has no more than 3 excused absences in the class for the semester. AND/OR
2. The student's semester average is a "B" in the class and the student has no more than 2 excused absences in the class for the semester. AND/OR
3. The student's semester average is a "C" in the class and the student has no more than 1 excused absence in the class for the semester. AND/OR
4. The student's semester average is a "D" in the class and the student has no absences in the class for the semester.

**Students will lose the option to be exempt from each semester exam if they have an unexcused absence from the class during the semester. In addition, students may not be exempt if they serve suspension time (in-school or out-of-school) and/or Saturday detention.

**Students who have presented a physician's diagnosis of infectious disease as documentation for their absences will be allowed the opportunity of semester test exemption, so long as all other absences and grades meet the regular semester test exemption policy. This documentation must be presented according to policy 4.7--Absences, not at the time of semester tests. This attendance exception will also apply to those students who can provide proper documentation of a mandatory quarantine due to a diagnosis of an infectious disease.
